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Recorder Reproducer Committee Report and Actions (Lorin Klein)

- IRIG 106-11 published 22 July 2011
 - Chapter 10: Added new data type TSPI/CTS (Time Space Position Information and Combat Training System) data type (Section 10.6.16). Several administrative changes were also made.
- STANAG 4575: Proposed Changes Under Consideration
 - New physical interface Ethernet w/ 1000BaseT- minimum
 - New Protocol iSCSI and/or dynamic IP addressing for multiple memory systems
 - Revising cable/connector requirements, power maintain Fiber Channel compatibility with ground stations
 - Shells for Ethernet should be MIL twist lock type
 - One power input is all that will be allowed
 - RMMs should allow for Ethernet or Fiber Channel transition to Ethernet alone

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Transducer Committee Report and Actions (Lee Eccles)

- IEEE 1451 current Transducer standards being followed
 - 1451.2 UART & SPI interfaces has been balloted and changes are being incorporated
 - 1451.4 TEDS associated with an analog transducer. This standard is being revised. Balloting closed March 1. Revised standard has not been released.
 - 1451.7 Transducer that communicates via an RFID chip. The chip is typically battery powered and is used for shipments. This standard was released in 2010

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Coding/Data Compression Committee Report and Actions (Sheila H.)

Subcommittee membership was reviewed.

- Provided feedback on CCSDS Red Book and agency review of CCSDS 123 "Lossless Multispectral & Hyperspectral Image Compression"
- ETSI REN/JTC-DVB-301 Digital Video Broadcasting: This document specifies a transmission system for hybrid satellite and terrestrial digital television broadcasting to mobile terminals. The purpose of the DVB-SH standard is to provide an efficient transmission system using frequencies below 3 GHz suitable for Satellite Services to Handheld devices, in terms of reception threshold and resistance to mobile satellite channel impairments. Reviews due by 12/7/2011
